CASTLE HILL

Castle Hill Hospital is the location for the majority of the Trust's elective activity. The hospital has the award winning Queen's Centre for Oncology and Haematology offering world class care for patients with cancer and blood disorders.

The Centre for Cardiology and Cardiothoracic Surgery bringing diagnostic and treatment facilities in one state-of-the-art building on the site. Breast Surgery and ENT services are provided in the Centenary building.

HULL ROYAL INFIRMARY

Based in the heart of Hull in one of the main arterial routes into the city. The main tower block was opened in 1967 by Her Majesty the Queen, and currently houses around 700 beds plus operating theatres.

The Hull Royal Infirmary is the main centre for emergency work at the Trust with the Emergency Department seeing over 120,000 people each year.

Our researchers both lead and contribute to research in a number of areas, helping us to understand diseases better, develop new treatments for the benefit of patients, relatives, carers, staff and the NHS overall.

Our ambition is to offer the chance of taking part in research to every patient that uses our services.

Our world class Daisy Research facility focuses on cancer scanning and is evolving to provide equivalent services for heart diseases and specific neurological diseases, including dementia. We are aiming to build a £6.4m radiochemistry and cyclotron unit so we can produce our own radioactive tracers. This will allow us to scan patients with certain heart and neurological conditions, including Alzheimer's, as well as those with cancer.
