### Nurseries planned

Building has now started on the **St Albans City Hospital** site. This will create a 48-place nursery, which will replace the existing nursery on that site. The opening is anticipated to be March 2004.

Once the land transfer has taken place (hopefully within the next few months) TLC are planning to build a 96 place nursery on land at the rear of Hemel Hempstead General Hospital, to incorporate a 24-place holiday play scheme. It is hoped that completion will be in time for summer 2004.


