



Highly Specialised Aseptic Service Pharmacist (8a)

Physical & Mental Requirements

Physical effort:

Combination of sitting, standing and walking. Light physical effort with occasional moderate effort. Walking between locations with occasional restricted position. Lifts and moves pharmacy boxes and fluids.

Emotional effort:

Occasional exposure to distressing circumstances such as distressed patients or drug misadventures.

Mental effort:

Required to use a VDU for several hours on a daily basis to input and extract data and to assess and act on complex information on the wards and/or in the pharmacy department.

Daily prolonged concentration for reviewing and analysing prescriptions, calculations, statistics and reports. Generally predictable work pattern but with frequent interruptions. May be interrupted by urgent requests for advice.

Working conditions:

Regular exposure to unpleasant working conditions such as odours from aseptic and cytotoxic production.
