The SATS and CAHMS LD inpatient service at Brooklands supports patients from all over the country. We have mixed gender beds for adults and younger people with a learning disability whose critical needs and behaviours of concern cannot be managed safely in a community setting. These individuals will typically have an additional psychiatric, behavioural and/or developmental disorder that has de-stabilised and requires a continual period of assessment and treatment. This service has several enhanced care suites within the units for individuals whose needs indicate that they may benefit from their own space, present with a level of challenging behaviour and/or mental health problems that are more intense and/or frequent in nature, thereby presenting a risk to those in the immediate vicinity.
